



## SENIOR NUGGETS - DECEMBER 2014

### **HELPFUL WINTER TIPS FOR YOUR CAR/HOME**

**Keep headlights clear with car wax.** Ordinary car wax wiped on headlights contains water repellents that prevent messy accumulation on lights and lasts 6 weeks

**Squeak-proof windshield wipers**

- use rubbing alcohol! Wipe the wipers with cloth saturated with rubbing alcohol or ammonia. This prevents badly streaking and squeaking wipers

**Ice-proof your windows with vinegar!**

Just fill a spray bottle with three parts vinegar to one part water & spritz it on all your windows at night. They'll be clear in the morning

**Prevent car doors from freezing shut with cooking oil**

Spritz cooking oil on rubber seals around car doors & rub it in with a paper towel. The spray prevents water from melting into the rubber

**Fog-proof your windshield with shaving cream!**

Spray some shaving cream on the inside of your windshield and wipe it off with paper towels. Shaving cream has same products as in defoggers

**De-ice your lock in seconds with hand sanitizer!**

Place some hand sanitizer gel on the key and the lock - problem solved!

## **PREPARE YOUR HOME FOR WINTER OUTAGES**

### **Items to have available**

- Generator (ideal to have for all seasons)
- Fully charged cell phones, portable radio and clocks
- Non-perishables food items, power bars, juices
- Bottled water (both for drinking/cooking and flushing toilets)
- Paper products (Toilet paper, tissue, paper plates, plastic cutlery, napkins)
- Grill, propane gas
- Manual can opener, spare flashlights, batteries, change of clothes, hand Sanitizers, room air spray

### **TIPS -**

**Take advantage of after holiday sales by purchasing cards and wrapping paper immediately after Christmas.**

- Use an ironing board for a wrapping center, its adjustable!
