WINTER TIPS

Keep headlights clear with car wax! Just wipe ordinary car wax on your headlights – wax lasts six weeks since it contains special water repellents that prevents messy mixture from accumulating on lights.

Squeak-proof your wipers with rubbing alcohol ! Wipe the wipers with a cloth saturated with rubbing alcohol and ammonia. This one trick keeps wiper change to near perfect silence.

Ice-proof your windows with vinegar! Just fill spray bottle with three parts vinegar to one part water & spritz it on all your windows at night. Vinegar contains acetic acid, which raises the melting point of water ... preventing water from freezing.

Prevent car doors from freezing shut with cooking spray! Spritz cooking oil on the rubber seal around car doors and rub it in with paper towels. The cooking oil prevents water from melting into the rubber.

Use hand sanitizer gel on the car key, door lock and problem is solved.

Fog-proof your windshield with shaving cream! Spray some shaving cream on the inside of your windshield and wipe it off with paper towels.

Keep an old pair of gloves in the car to wear while pumping gas.

Have an emergency blanket and flares in each car.
